CIVIL RIGHTS PROCEDURE

A person wishing to file a discrimination complaint related to the School Nutrition Program will be provided a complaint form without attempting to resolve the complaint first. The Child Nutrition staff will provide the USDA Program Discrimination Complaint Form. The form and instructions can also be downloaded from <https://www.usda.gov/sites/default/files/documents/USDA-OASCR%20P-Complaint-Form-0508-0002-508-11-28-17Fax2Mail.pdf>.

This form can be completed verbally, in writing or in person. Complaints may be filed with the school cafeteria manager or directly at the Child Nutrition Office. When completing the form, the person receiving the complaint and transcribing the complaint, if applicable, must be listed on the form.

Any Civil Rights complaints received related to the School Nutrition Program are forwarded to the Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA).

If the form is being sent to the USDA, then it must also be forwarded to TDA. If thron filing the complaint wishes the file the complaint themselves, the Child Nutrition staff will provide these addresses:

In accordance with Federal civil rights law and U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) civil rights regulations and policies, the USDA, its Agencies, offices, and employees, and institutions participating in or administering USDA programs are prohibited from discriminating based on race, color, national origin, sex, disability, age, or reprisal or retaliation for prior civil rights activity in any program or activity conducted or funded by USDA.
