Uniforms are **REQUIRED** Monday through Friday, **NO EXCEPTIONS**

<p><u>MONDAY Formal Requirements</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Short or Long Sleeve White Peter Pan Collar Shirts (Girls) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Must be buttoned to the top • Short or Long Sleeve White Button down Oxford Shirts (Girls/Boys) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Long sleeves must be buttoned • Shirts must be tucked in at all times • Only Solid White undershirts allowed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ No colored or logo shirts allowed underneath uniform shirt <p><u>TUESDAY – FRIDAY Requirements</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Green or Navy Land's End UNHP Logo Polo • Shirts must be tucked in at all times • Only Solid White undershirts allowed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ No colored or logo shirts allowed underneath uniform shirt 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Navy Blue Uniform Pants <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Must be worn Mondays starting October 1st • Navy Blue Uniform Shorts <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ May be worn Tuesday – Friday • Pants/Shorts should be worn appropriately and modestly • Kindergarten and 1st Grade may wear elastic waist Pants/Shorts • Plaid Land's End Uniform Jumper <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Must be worn on Mondays ○ Must be worn with Land's End Solid Navy Blue modesty shorts underneath ○ No long pants under allowed underneath • Plaid Land's End Skort <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ May be worn Tuesday – Friday • Jumper/Skort may not be shorter than width of credit card measured at the back of the knee • Jumper/Skort's waistband must be at the waist
OUTERWEAR / BACKPACKS / UMBRELLAS / RAINCOATS / PONCHOS	BELTS / SOCKS/ SHOES / TIGHTS
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Green Land's End Sweater, Cardigan, or Vests may be worn in the classroom • Green or Navy Blue Land's End Sweatshirt or Fleece may be worn in the classroom • Backpacks should be an appropriate size for your scholar <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Rolling backpacks are not allowed ○ Items such as key chains that dangle are not allowed ○ Scholars are encouraged to limit the weight in their backpack • Umbrellas are not allowed • Raincoats or Ponchos are allowed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Scholars are encouraged to keep a poncho in their backpack at all times 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Black Belt woven or flat with a small buckle <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Required for 2nd – 5th grade ○ No design or logo buckles/belts allowed • Socks must be solid navy blue, white or black <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ No socks with designs or logos allowed ○ Knee length socks preferred with Jumper/Skorts ○ Socks must cover the ankle bone ○ <u>No-show socks are not allowed</u> • Girl's Shoes must be all white athletic tennis shoes (with white laces) Boy's Shoes must be all black athletic tennis shoes (with black laces) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Kindergarten and 1st Grade may wear shoes above with Velcro ○ Shoe accessories are not allowed ○ Shoes and laces must be kept in good condition ○ <u>Dress shoes are not allowed</u> • Tights (waist to toe) can be worn in solid navy blue, opaque white or black <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Socks may not be worn over tights ○ <u>Leggings are not permitted</u>

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HEADWEAR / HAIR / MAKE-UP / NAIL POLISH	Primary College/Spirit Wear Fridays
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hats, Caps, Visors, Sunglasses or other Headwear are not allowed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Hair accessories and cultural head covers must match a color in the jumper (blue, white, black, green, or yellow) • Hair must be clean, nearly styled, not covering the eyes and be of naturally occurring hair color <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ scholar are not allowed to color their hair • Make-Up / Artificial Nails are not allowed 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On Fridays, scholars are encouraged to wear appropriately fitting college t-shirts, college polos, or college crewneck sweatshirts with their uniform pants/skirts and shoes. • Scholars may also choose to wear North Hills spirit t-shirts with their uniform pants/skirts and shoes on Fridays. • No scholars may wear other college gear, including jackets or hoodies. • All shirts must be worn tucked into their pants or skirt.
WATCHES / JEWELRY / BADGES	Primary Casual Days
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scholars are permitted to wear noiseless wrist watches • Scholars are permitted to wear pierced stud earrings only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Dangling earrings including hoops may not be worn for safety reasons. ○ If earrings are worn for religious reasons and are outside of our policy, they must be covered and not visible at all times. • If a scholar wears jewelry for religious reasons, it should be worn under the blouse or shirt. • Primary scholars may not wear bracelets except for religious reasons. • Identification Badges must be worn at all times and display it in a visible location (e.g. worn on the left side of the shirt or sweater) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Scholars will be given an ID badge at the beginning of the school year ○ Scholars with damaged, altered, defaced, or lost ID badges shall purchase a replacement ID badge <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ A replacement fee of <u>\$10.00</u> shall be assessed for each occurrence of a lost/damaged ID badges. ○ Primary scholars may not wear lanyards. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Casual dress days will be made available at designated times throughout the school year • All scholars in good academic and disciplinary standing will have a casual day the last day of each quarter <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Casual dress privileges may be revoked for scholars who do not comply with all dress code policies, as determined by the administration. • On approved casual days, only shirts that do not display offensive language or images of violence, drugs, alcohol, tobacco or the occult may be worn <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Shirts must have sleeves, cover the midriff area and is not be low-cut. • Shorts and skirts adhering to the uniform code for length may be worn <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Tears or holes are not allowed • Leggings are permitted only with a top or dress worn over that adheres to the uniform code for length • Clothing must follow the same guidelines for fit and length as comparable to the uniform • Athletic uniform clothing may be worn <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Sweat pants and yoga pants are not allowed • Scholars must wear closed toe shoes that they can run around and remain safe, preferably athletic shoes. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Heelys are not allowed.
