Additional Notes:

- All shirts and outerwear should have the appropriate Uplift Elevate Logo.
- No outside hoodies/colorful jackets allowed at school. Sweater/Cardigans must be entirely navy, grey, or black! Coats should be worn during winter months; they will not be permitted in the classroom.
- Scholars must wear shorts under skirts & jumpers. During colder months girls are permitted to wear black/white leggings under their jumpers.
- Skirts/Jumpers/Skorts/ can be no more than 2 inches above the knee.
- No denim, lace, or cargo pants.
- All color shoes are permitted. Athletic shoes permitted. Non-marking dress shoes or flats are permitted.
- No high heels, flip flops, or crocs
- Backpacks can be any design, style, color.
- Skirts and shorts must meet uniform length requirements.
- No flip flop, crocs, or pajama wear
- No revealing clothing, or inappropriate language or graphics on clothing.
- If purchasing from an outside vendor, colors must be an EXACT match
