Texas Public Information Act, Designation of Non-Business Days

Regulation Effective Date: September 1, 2023

Law. Subject to the requirements of this subsection, a governmental body may designate a day on which the governmental body's administrative offices are closed or operating with minimum staffing as a nonbusiness day. The designation of a non-business day for an independent school district must be made by the board of trustees. The designation of a non-business day for a governmental body other than an independent school district must be made by the executive director or other chief administrative officer. A governmental body may designate not more than 10 nonbusiness days under this subsection each calendar year.

Texas Government Code, §522.0031

Designation of Non-Business Days. The Chief Executive Officer has designated the 10 weekdays of Winter Break as the 10 non-business days for purposes of Texas Government Code, §522.0031. Should Winter Break extend beyond 10 weekdays, the first 10 weekdays of the-then Winter Break shall be the 10 non-business days for purposes of Texas Government Code, §522.0031.
