

All scholars in grades 11-12 are required to participate in some component of the IB Diploma Programme. Scholars pursuing the full IB Diploma will complete two years of at least 3 Higher Level (HL) IB courses and two years of at least 3 Standard Level (SL) IB courses.

Enrollment in AP and DP courses are contingent upon completion of prerequisites, departmental approval, assessment data, grades and teacher recommendation.

Uplift Heights Preparatory is a tuition-free, public charter school within the Uplift Education network. Our college preparatory curriculum is designed to foster a stronger college going culture within the traditionally under resourced West Dallas community, where 31% of individuals live below the poverty line and 6% of adults have a college degree. As the third graduating class, our seniors are committed to pursuing higher education opportunities despite many historical and systemic barriers.

## COMMUNITY SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

Community service and social responsibility are an integral part of Uplift Heights. Scholars are required to complete community service hours as a part of the Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) component of the Diploma Programme.

#### EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Uplift Heights offers 26 different extracurricular opportunities. This includes organizations such as Science Bowl, Just Say Yes, Peer Mediation and Diversity Club, in addition to, Basketball (M/W), Track (M/W), Soccer (M/W), Flag Football (M), Volleyball (W), Cheerleading (Co-ed), Dance (Co-ed).

## CURRICULUM AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Academic Rigor: Uplift Heights is committed to exposing all scholars to a rigorous college preparatory curriculum. The International Baccalaureate model encourages students to be internationally minded and academically well-rounded. As an IB continuum school, Uplift Heights Preparatory is authorized to offer the Primary Years Programme (PYP), Middle Years Programme (MYP), and the Diploma Programme (DP).

IB For All: Uplift is a DP For ALL network and is committed to making sure that all scholars, regardless of their background or educational need, have access to participate in the Diploma Programme. Scholars pursuing the IB Diploma are also required to participate in the DP Core. This requires scholars to take a Theory of Knowledge course, complete Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) experiences, and write the Extended Essay, Current seniors have also had opportunities to participate in Advanced Placement and Dual Credit coursework.

Course Schedule: Uplift operates on a semester system. Classes rotate on an A/B Block Schedule with five days of four 90-minute periods. Four days a week the schedule also includes advisory and an additional enrichment/intervention block.

Graduation Requirements: Scholars must attempt the full Foundation High School Program, at least one Endorsement and the Distinguished Level of Achievement (26+ credits). Any scholar graduating on the Foundation Only program (22 credits) requires additional approval. Scholars must complete the following:




