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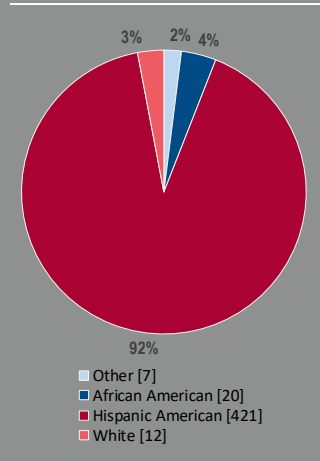

ABOUT OUR SCHOOL

Uplift Peak Preparatory is a tuition-free, public charter school managed by the Uplift Education charter school network. Uplift Peak offers a college-preparatory curriculum to a diverse urban population of scholars in grades Pre-K through 12, in the eastern sector of Dallas, Texas. Our vision is to provide a joyful and inquiry-based education that inspires and prepares all scholars to graduate from college and positively impact their world.

COMMUNITY SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

Community service and social responsibility are an integral part of Uplift Peak. Scholars are required to complete community service experiences as a part of the Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) component of the Diploma Programme.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Uplift Peak offers 29 different extracurricular opportunities. These include organizations such as Art Club, Chess Club, Clash Royale Club, Creative Writing and Music Club, Freedom of Expression, Garden Club, German Club, Glee Club, Movie Club, National Honor Society, Practical Living Skills, Production Club, Recycling Club, Runners and Walkers, Senior Committee, Soccer Club, Spanish National Honor Society, Scholar Council, Speech and Debate, Sunshine Committee, Super Smash Club, Yearbook, and Young Gentlemen's Club, in addition to the following UIL 3A Varsity athletic programs: Basketball (M/W), Cross Country (Co-Ed), Soccer (M/W), Flag Football (M), Volleyball (W), Cheerleading (Co-Ed).

CURRICULUM AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Academic Rigor: Uplift Peak is committed to exposing all scholars to a rigorous college preparatory curriculum. The International Baccalaureate® model encourages students to be internationally minded and academically well-rounded. As an IB continuum school, Peak is authorized to offer the Primary Years Programme (PYP), Middle Years Programme (MYP), and the Diploma Programme (DP).

IB For All: Uplift is a DP For ALL network and is committed to making sure that all scholars, regardless of their background or educational need, have access to participate in the Diploma Programme. Scholars pursuing the full IB Diploma are also required to participate in the DP Core. This requires scholars to take a Theory of Knowledge course, complete Creativity, Activity, and Service (CAS) experiences, and write an Extended Essay. Current seniors have also had opportunities to participate in Advanced Placement and Dual Credit coursework.

Course Schedule: Uplift operates on a semester system. Classes rotate on an A/B Block Schedule with five days of four 90-minute periods. Four days a week the schedule also includes advisory and an additional enrichment/intervention block.

Graduation Requirements: Scholars must attempt the full Foundation High School Program, at least one Endorsement and the Distinguished Level of Achievement (26+ credits). Any scholar graduating on the Foundation Only program (22 credits) requires additional approval. Scholars must complete the following:

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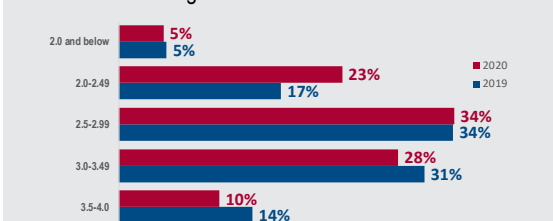

GRADING SYSTEM

- Honors/Pre-AP/Dual Credit courses receive an extra 0.5 points for C- and above in calculating the weighted GPA.
- AP/DP courses receive an extra 1.0 points for C- and above in calculating the weighted GPA.
- Credit recovery is mandatory for all failed courses required for graduation, all attempts are included on the transcript and calculated into the GPA.
- Pass/Fail, Local Credit, HS credit earned in Middle School, and courses for which the scholar received prior credit, are not included in the GPA.
- It is Uplift Education's policy not to rank scholars.

ADVANCED COURSES

- All courses in grades 6-10 are taught as part of the IB Middle Years Programme unless otherwise noted.
- All scholars in grades 11-12 are required to participate in some component of the IB Diploma Programme. Scholars pursuing the full IB Diploma will complete two years of at least 3 Higher Level (HL) IB courses and two years of at least 3 Standard Level (SL) IB courses.
- Enrollment in AP and DP courses are contingent upon completion of prerequisites, departmental approval, assessment data, grades and teacher recommendation.

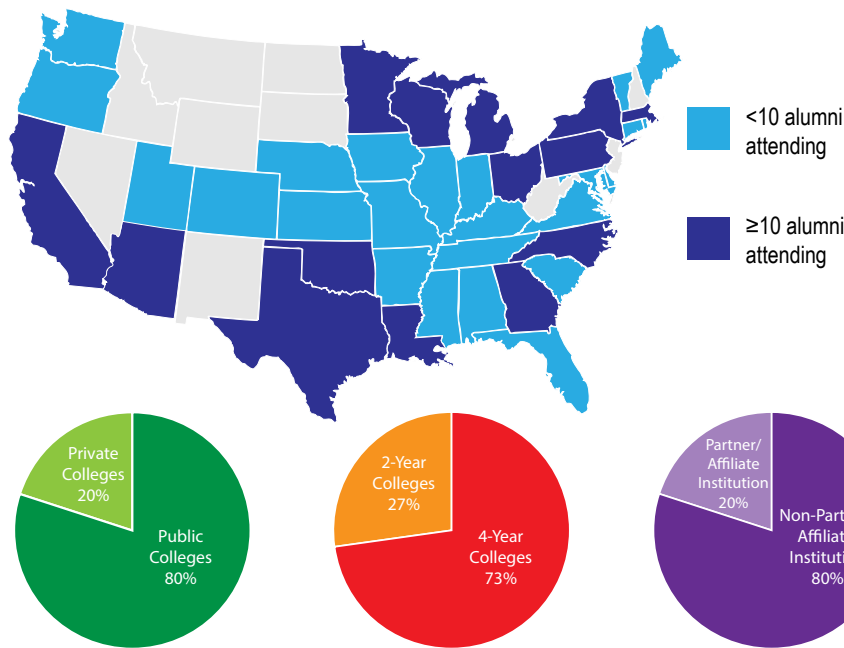
