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

ABOUT OUR SCHOOL

Uplift Williams Preparatory is a tuition-free, public charter school managed by the Uplift Education charter school network. Uplift Williams offers a collegepreparatory education with a global perspective to scholars in Dallas. As a Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) school, Uplift Williams also offers scholars unique opportunities for learning in these fields through a partnership with UT Southwestern Medical Center.

COMMUNITY SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

Uplift Williams scholars are required to complete community service experiences as a part of the Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) component of the IB Diploma Programme. With its holistic approach, CAS is designed to strengthen and extend students' personal and interpersonal learning through experiences.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Uplift Williams offers 21 different extracurricular opportunities. These include organizations such as KPOP, Drill team, Gay/ Straight Alliance, Performance Club, Chess Club, Band, Dungeons and Dragons Club, Studio Art, Zine Club (literary arts), Yearbook, UIL Theater, Student Council, , Robotics, Folklorico, and Diverse Lounge, in addition to the following UIL-4A Varsity athletic programs: Basketball (M/W), Cross Country (M/W), Track and Field (M/W), Golf (M/W), Soccer (M/W), Volleyball (W), and Cheerleading (Co-Ed).

CURRICULUM AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Academic Rigor: Uplift Williams is committed to exposing all scholars to a rigorous college preparatory curriculum. The International Baccalaureate model encourages students to be internationally minded and academically well-rounded. As an IB continuum school, Uplift Williams is authorized to offer the Primary Years Programme (PYP), Middle Years Programme (MYP), and the Diploma Programme (DP).

IB For All: Uplift is a DP For ALL network and is committed to making sure that all scholars, regardless of their background or educational need, have access to participate in the Diploma Programme. Scholars pursuing the full IB Diploma are also required to participate in the DP Core. This requires scholars to take a Theory of Knowledge course, complete Creativity, Activity, and Service (CAS) experiences, and write an Extended Essay. Current seniors have also had opportunities to participate in Advanced Placement and Dual Credit coursework.

Course Schedule: Uplift operates on a semester system. Classes rotate on an A/B Block Schedule with five days of four 90-minute periods. Four days a week the schedule also includes an enrichment/intervention block.

Graduation Requirements: Scholars must attempt the full Foundation High School Program, at least one Endorsement and the Distinguished Level of Achievement (26+ credits). Any scholar graduating on the Foundation Only program (22 credits) requires additional approval. Scholars must complete the following:



GRADING SYSTEM

- Pre-AP/Dual Credit courses receive an extra 0.5 points for C- and above in calculating the weighted GPA.
- AP/DP courses receive an extra 1.0 points for C- and above in calculating the weighted GPA.
- · Credit recovery is mandatory for all failed courses required for graduation, all attempts are included on the transcript and calculated into the GPA.
- · Pass/Fail, Local Credit, HS credit earned in Middle School, and courses for which the scholar received prior credit, are not included in the GPA.
- It is Uplift Education's policy not to rank scholars.

ADVANCED COURSES

- All courses in grades 6-10 are taught as part of the IB Middle Years Programme unless otherwise noted.
- All scholars in grades 11-12 are required to participate in some component of the IB Diploma Programme. Scholars pursuing the full IB Diploma will complete two years of at least 3 Higher Level (HL) IB courses and two years of at least 3 Standard Level (SL) IB courses.
- Enrollment in AP and DP courses are contingent upon completion of prerequisites, departmental approval, assessment data, grades and teacher recommendation.


