A Message from Administration

Dear Panther Families,

Your scholars have been talking the MAP test for the last two weeks. This assessment allows us to see how much growth your scholars has made and gives us insight into what your scholars still needs support in. To help reinforce what scholars are receiving from teachers at school, there are a few things at home that you can do to support your scholar's academic growth:

- Read a book with your scholars. Try holding D-E-A-R times at your house. "DEAR" stands for "Drop Everything and Read." During DEAR time, everyone in the family sits down for some uninterrupted reading time.
- Ask your scholars questions about the book. What is the main idea? Tell me more about the characters in the book. Tell me or write a summary of the book.
- Work on math facts with your children, addition and subtraction. This will help build their mental math skills.
- Have your scholars practice counting money, both coins and bills.
