

UWP Primary Uniform Expectations

Uniforms are **REQUIRED** Monday through Friday, **NO EXCEPTIONS**

| MONDAY - FRIDAY | BOTTOMS |
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| <p>MON.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Short or Long Sleeve White oxford shirt with crest and tie. • Black, Gray, or Navy-Blue Bottoms for Boys <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Girls may wear the plaid skirts as well • Long sleeves must be buttoned • Shirts must be always tucked in • Only Solid White undershirts allowed <p>No colored or logo shirts allowed underneath uniform shirt</p> <p>TUE. To THUR.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Short or Long Sleeve Navy Blue Collared shirt • Black, Gray, or Navy-Blue Bottoms for Boys <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Girls may wear the plaid skirts as well • Long sleeves must be buttoned • Shirts must be always tucked in • Only Solid White undershirts allowed <p>No colored or logo shirts allowed underneath uniform shirt</p> <p>FRIDAY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On Fridays and Friday's Only scholars may wear jeans with a university or school uniform shirt including Williams spirit shirts. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Navy Blue, Gray and Black Uniform Pants • Pants/Shorts should be worn appropriately and modestly • Kindergarten and 1st Grade <i>only</i>- may wear elastic waist Pants/Shorts • Plaid Mills Uniform Jumper <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ ◦ Must be worn with Mills Solid Navy Blue modesty shorts underneath ◦ No long pants under allowed underneath <p>Plaid Mills Skort</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jumper/Skort may not be shorter than width of credit card measured at the back of the knee • Jumper/Skort's waistband must be at the waist |

**OUTERWEAR / BACKPACKS / UMBRELLAS /
RAINCOATS / PONCHOS**

- Navy Blue Mills **Sweater, Cardigan, or Vests** may be worn in the classroom
- Navy Blue Mills **Sweatshirt** or **Fleece** may be worn in the classroom
- **Backpacks must be Clear and** should be an appropriate size for your scholar
 - Rolling backpacks are not allowed
 - Items such as key chains that dangle are not allowed
 - Scholars are encouraged to limit the weight in their backpack
- **Raincoats** or **Ponchos** are allowed
Scholars are encouraged to keep a poncho in their backpack at all times

BELTS / SOCKS/ SHOES / TIGHTS

- **Black Belt** woven or flat with a small buckle
 - Required for 1st – 5th grade
 - No design or logo buckles/belts allowed
- **Socks** must be solid navy blue, white or black
 - No socks with designs or logos allowed
 - Knee length socks preferred with Jumper/Skorts
 - Socks must cover the ankle bone
 - No-show socks are not allowed
- **Shoes** must be all white athletic tennis shoes (with white laces) or must be all black athletic tennis shoes (with black laces)
 - Pre-K and Kindergarten may wear shoes above with Velcro
 - Shoe accessories are not allowed
 - Shoes and laces must be kept in good condition
 - Dress shoes are not allowed
 - Scholars must wear closed toe shoes that
 - they can run around and remain safe,
 - preferably athletic shoes.
 - Heelys are not allowed
- **Tights** (waist to toe) can be worn in solid navy blue, opaque white or black
 - Socks may not be worn over tights
 - Leggings are not permitted

| HEADWEAR / HAIR / MAKE-UP | Primary College/Spirit Wear Fridays |
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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hats, Caps, Visors, Sunglasses or other Headwear are not allowed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Hair accessories and cultural head covers must match a color in the jumper (blue, white, black, green, or yellow) • Hair must be clean, nearty styled, not covering the eyes and be of naturally occurring hair color • Make-Up/ Artificial Nails are not allowed | <p>On Fridays, scholars are encouraged to wear appropriately fitting college t-shirts, college polos, or college crewneck sweatshirts with jeans (no ripped jeans)</p> <p>Scholars may also choose to wear Williams spirit t-shirts with their uniform pants/skirts and shoes on Fridays</p> <p>No scholars may wear other college gear, including jackets or hoodies.</p> |
| WATCHES / JEWELRY / BADGES | Primary Casual Days |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scholars are permitted to wear noiseless wrist watches. No smartwatches of any kind allowed. • Scholars are permitted to wear pierced stud earrings only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Dangling earrings including hoops may not be worn for safety reasons. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ If earrings are worn for religious reasons and are outside of our policy, they must be covered and not visible at all times. • If a scholar wears jewelry for religious reasons, it should be worn under the blouse or shirt. Primary scholars may not wear • bracelets except for religious reasons. <p style="text-align: center;">_____</p> <p>Uniforms must be purchased from Unique Apparel Designs or Affordable Uniforms</p> | <p>Casual dress days will be made available at designated times throughout the school year</p> <p>Casual dress privileges may be revoked for scholars who do not comply with all dress code policies, as determined by the administration.</p> <p>On approved casual days, only shirts that do not display offensive language or images of violence, drugs, alcohol, tobacco or the occult may be worn</p> <p>Shirts must have sleeves, cover the midriff area and is not be low-cut.</p> <p>Shorts and skirts adhering to the uniform code for length may be worn</p> <p>Tears or holes are not allowed</p> <p>Leggings are permitted only with a top or dress worn over what adheres to the uniform code for length</p> <p>Clothing must follow the same guidelines for fit and length as comparable to the uniform Athletic uniform clothing may be worn</p> <p>Sweat pants and yoga pants are not allowed</p> |
