I. Call to Order and Announcements	R. Frapart welcomed the Board to the meeting and took attendance. A quorum being present, the meeting was called to order at 8:03 a.m.	
II. Admissions and Enrollment policy	A Berk introduced the updated Admissions and Enrollment policy. A. Berk explained to the Board that the State now requires by law all open-enrollment charters use a common application created by the State, called the Charter Student Admission Application (CSAA). Based on the new law, TEA created a two-part process for admissions and enrollment: 1. Admissions (CSAA application) - student's name, date of birth, gender, grade applying for, parent/guardian, address of the student, and a phone number 2. Enrollment (collect other information) - student's health records, records pertaining to special education, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act, and dyslexia, academic records, verification of address, and in some instances, discipline records.	Upon motion by J. Beckert to approve the resolution approving the updated Admissions and Enrollment policy, as presented, and seconded by L. Melville, the Board unanimously voted to approve the motion.
